**Minutes of the State Level Udyog Mitra Meeting held on 18<sup>th</sup> March, 2007 at 2.00 p.m. in the Committee Room of Directorate of Industries, New Administrative Bldg. Mantralaya, Mumbai-400032.**

The State Level Udyog Mitra Meeting was held on 18<sup>th</sup> March -2007 at 2.00 p.m. under the Chairmanship of Development Commissioner (Industries), in the Committee Room of the Directorate of Industries, New Administrative Building Opposite Mantralaya, Mumbai - 400032.

1. List of the participants is annexed herewith.
2. At the outset the Chairman, SUM welcomed all the participants.
3. In the opening remarks the Chairman, SUM, impressed upon the Officers / Members that the decision taken in the State Level Udyog Mitra Meeting needs to be taken seriously and time limits specified shall followed scrupulously. All the issues have to be sorted out quickly and compliance of it should be informed to the concerned Association and SUM invariably.
4. The Summery of discussions on various issues deliberated in the Officers Meeting and those raised in Industries Association Meeting are appended.
5. The issues on agenda note at 3.2 were new, therefore concerned Officers were informed to take note to forward their comments by 31st May,2007.
6. All Association explained the Chairman the hardship that would be faced by industries due to Solvents Order, 2000 came into force. Officers from Food and Civil Supplies Department explained the procedure adopted for finalizing form and enclosures to be submitted. All industries are using solvents, as their raw material / fuel are likely to face hardship due to misinterpretation of said order. All Association requested the Chairman to intervene the matter for withdrawal of this order for the industries storing solvents as their fuel / raw material. The Chairman advised representative from F & CSD to organize separate meeting with Industries Associations in consultation with Principal Secretary, F & CSD at an early date to sort-out grievances.
7. Meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to the chair and members present.
