

Date: 24<sup>th</sup> Dec 2009, Corrigendum No. 1 for Tender No: DIT 09/File 09/23

In response to queries/suggestions made by the prospective bidders, following corrigendum is issued with respect to Tender No: DIT 09/File 09/23:

1. Tender clause 7.5 "The e-Tendering solution proposed for this product should have been tested and approved by STQC or any other Government organizations providing quality certifications. In case the product has not been tested and approved by STQC or any other Government organizations providing quality certifications, the bidder and the OEM needs to give an undertaking that they would get the product certified within 3 months of award of contract" **read as** "The e-Tendering solution proposed for this product should have been tested and approved by STQC or any other Government organizations providing quality certifications. In case the product has not been tested and approved by STQC or any other Government organizations providing quality certifications, the bidder needs to give an undertaking that they would get the product certified within 3 months of award of contract."
2. Tender clause 9.11 (xiii) is changed to "The Bidder is expected to submit a statement agreeing to relinquish source code (including all necessary documentation) along with the Technical Proposal. Non-receipt of such a statement shall make the bid as being unresponsive and shall lead to disqualification of the bid"
3. Tender Clause 6.12 is changed to "The condition is changed to "The maximum penalty at any point of time and for any period should not exceed the monthly transaction charges earned by the successful bidder in the last three (3) months""
4. Tender Clause 7.6 – Technical Evaluation Criteria (ii) is changed to "Number of projects in India in last 3 years in e-Procurement with Government sector (10) {Applicable to the bidder/prime bidder in case of a consortium or the OEM whose e-Tendering solution is proposed for the project }
5. Tender Clause 7.6 – Technical Evaluation Criteria (iv) to be changed to "It is changed to "Client Performance statements of past e-Tendering projects implemented which are running for more than 2 years (10) {Applicable to the bidder/prime bidder in case of a consortium or the OEM whose e-Tendering solution is proposed for the project}"
6. The last date of submission of bid is extended to 8<sup>th</sup> Jan 2010. The time and place of submission remains the same.

As regard to other queries/suggestions, the terms and conditions mentioned in the tender document remains unchanged
