**NOTIFICATION**

**NO. MLV/MISC/270/2008/3149**

**NAGPUR, DATED:- 8 Oct 2008**

As per provisions of Mines and Minerals ( Development and Regulation) Act 1957 under section 11 (2) and (4) various major mineral bearing areas from different districts in the state were notified for mineral concessions (i.e. for mining lease /Prospecting Licence) vide Directorate's notification No. MLV/MISC/270/2006/3682, dated 12.10.2006. However while notifying, mineral concession areas, they are shown available for ML / PL. However those areas which are notified for both M.L. or P.L. are required to be renotified specifically either for M.L. or P.L. as per directives given by Govt. vide letter No. MNG-1005/Pra.Kra.958/IND-9, dtd 25.3.2008.

Therefore the areas mentioned below are being renotified specifically for M.L. or P.L. under sub sec. 2 and 4 of sec. 11 of Mines and Minerals (Development & Regulation) Act 1957. In this respect, mineral concession applications are to be submitted in prescribed format of ML or PL as the case may be given in Mineral Concession Rules 1960. Desirous applicant should apply for mineral concession within 30 days from the date of publication of this notification in Maharashtra Govt. Gazette and submit ML/PL application to District Mining Officer of concerned collectorate.

Applicants who have applied for mining lease and/or prospecting licence as per Directorate's notification dt. 12.10.2006, now if required, such desirous applicants may also submit revised application in prescribed format (With essential documents) to concerned District Mining Officer, in collectorate within stipulated time.
