The Industry representatives suggested that the issues to be tackled need to be prioritised so that a strong focus to achieve is built up. Also, necessary push needs to be given to establish the incubation and start up centres to promote the innovations.

Hon'ble CM directed that a Task Force on the e-Governance be formed which will include the stake holders from the Industry and Government. This task force will act as a think tank and meet periodically to discuss on the various aspects of IT, e-Governance and the Industry and advise the Government on the measures to be taken. DIT will move the proposal through Pr. Secretary Industries to CMO to establish the task force immediately.
